1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against them vide FIR No.53 dated 14.05.2017, registered at Police Station Kathunagal, District Amritsar, under Sections 498-A and 406 of IPC.
2. On one of the earlier dates of hearing, it had been represented that the parties have entered into a compromise. On the last date of hearing, the matter had been adjourned to enable the petitioner to apprise this Court about the status of compromise.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has today furnished a photocopy of the statement of the complainant-Sumandeep Kaur recorded during the course of proceedings of petition under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act wherein, she has categorically stated that the matter has been resolved amongst the parties and that she has received back all the articles of *istridhan*.

4. In view of the aforestated position where the parties have amicably resolved their issues, custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 08.06.2017 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
