It has been noticed that counsel for the petitioners has not been appearing for the last 5 dates of hearing.

Status report by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, has been filed in court today, which is taken on record.

The present petition was filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“4. That an order or direction may be issued to the respondents no.2 and 3 not to arrest the petitioners, in FIR No.243 dated 13.04.2016 under Section 302/34 IPC, Police Station Gohana, District Sonipat (Haryana), Annexure P-1 and if at all the petitioners are required to be arrested, the petitioner may be released on furnishing of bail bonds along with surety as deemed fit.

5. That the petitioners are willing to join the

investigation, for which date and time may kindly be fixed by this Honourable High Court.”

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar has submitted that petitioner no.1 had joined investigation and no incriminating material was found against petitioner no.1. However, petitioner no.2 inspite of repeated notices is not coming forward to join investigation. He has further pointed out that warrants for arrest of petitioner no.2 have been got issued through Court for today i.e. 27.08.2019.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case and the affidavit filed by the respondent-State, this Court is of the view that no protection can be granted to petitioner no.2 in this petition.

Hence, disposed of.
