INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.64 dated 22.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 302, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that though the present petitioner is

not named in the FIR, yet he has been named in the supplementary statement. Though specific injury has not been attributed to him, yet general allegations have been levelled that he has caused injuries to the deceased. He has earlier remained proclaimed offender and if the bail is granted to him, there is every chance that he may again abscond.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, however, without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
