KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the FIR No. 54 dated 01.02.2010 under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

Heard.

Vide order dated 21.08.2018, both the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar vide its letter dated 25.10.2018 has reported that statements of both the parties have been recorded. Learned Magistrate has reported that parties have willfully settled their differences and reached at bona fide compromise without any pressure and the same seems to be genuine.

Since the matter has been compromised and the trial of the case will be useless exercise, FIR No. 54 dated 01.02.2010 under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar along with consequential proceedings qua petitioner stands quashed.

Petition stands allowed.
