MAHESH GROVER, J.(O)

The petitioner has merely impugned a public notice which directs him to submit his response, failing which the bank guarantee furnished by him would be encashed for failure to deposit the external development charges.

The petitioner contends that he has submitted several representations prior to that which satisfactorily explained his case and would liberate him from any demand on account of external development. He refers to Annexures P-39 and P-40 and also states at the bar that these representations sufficiently contained the stand of the petitioner which should have been considered by the respondents rather than going in for a notice Annexure P-41 with a veiled threat of encashment of bank guarantee.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and noticing that the petitioner has merely impugned a notice, we would not interfere in the matter at this stage, but since the petitioner states that he has submitted representations, which are sufficient to meet the requirement of the notice, we would deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition at this stage with a direction to the respondents to consider the representations

(Annexures P-39 and 40) filed by the petitioner as a response to the public notice (Annexure P-41) and take a decision thereon after hearing the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Ordered accordingly.

Till then i.e. till decision of the matter by the competent authority no coercive steps be taken.
