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**HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for directing the respondents Nos. 1 and 2 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and further prayed for directing respondents Nos. 3 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

On 25.11.2019, the directions were issued by this Court for filing personal affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda. In compliance of the above order, the affidavit of Dr. Nanak Singh, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda has been filed which is taken on record.

As per the report, it has been found that the petitioners are drug peddler and following cases have been found registered against them:-

(a) That a case FIR No. 96 dated 04.08.2007, under Section 18, 25 NDPS Act was registered at P. S. City Rampura against petitioner Vijay Kumar, his brother Surinder Kumar, Karamjit Singh son of Gurdev Singh, resident of village Sidhana and Smt. Saroj Taneja. In this case, 4 kg 500 gram opium was recovered and the accused were convicted for 10 years RI and a fine of Rs. 1 lakh each was also imposed.

(b) That a case FIR no. 85 dated 05.08.2015, under Section 18 NDPS Act, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC was registered at P. S. City Rampura against Surinder Kumar alias Rimppi brother of petitioner no. 1 and son of petitioner no. 2 and 3. In this case, 5 kg opium and a car were recovered. On completion, the investigation challan has been presented and now trial is pending against accused Surinder Kumar alias Rimpi.

(c) That a case FIR No. 89 dated 01.11.2016, under Section 18 NDPS Act is registered at P. S. City Rampura against petitioner no. 3 Mansa Devi and co-accused Surinder Kumar alias Rimpi son of petitioner no. 2 Saroop Chand. In this case, 500 gram opium was recovered and both the accused had been acquitted by the learned Trial Court.

(d) That a case FIR No. 63 dated 31.05.2017, under Section 18 NDPS Act, 25 Arms Act of P. S. City Rampura registered against Surinder Kumar alias Rimpi. In this case, 1 kg 200 gram opium, currency notes of Rs. 24,93,900/-, 12 live cartridges of different bores were recovered. Trial is pending in this case.

(e) That a case FIR No. 45 dated 04.05.2019, under Section 18 NDPS Act was registered at P. S. City Rampura against accused Surinder Kumar alias Rimpi son of petitioner no. 2 and 3. In this case, 1 kg 500 gram opium was recovered from the conscious possession of the accused and the trial is pending against the accused.

As per the affidavit, there are other FIR also registered against the accused. No case is made out.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is dismissed.
