ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.160 dated 11.04.2013, under Sections 167, 194, 195, 197, 198, 218, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a misunderstanding which has now been settled. Although the challan has been presented under the afore-noted sections but charges were framed only under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC. He further states that the matter has been compromised. Copy of the compromise dated 07.05.2019 is taken on record.

A coordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 28.07.2015 had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court

and on his doing so, he was to be released on interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was released on interim bail by the trial Court.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the matter has been compromised and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
