Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of order dated 29.04.2013 (P-5), passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, whereby the application of the petitioner for releasing the Zen Estilo Car bearing registration No.PB-08-BP-1078 on *Sapurdari* has been declined. The Car was detained by the police in FIR No.266 dated 08.11.2010, under Sections 382 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar. Further challenge is to the order dated 04.04.2014 (P-7), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, whereby his revision has also been dismissed against the above order.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue the civil suit(s), already pending between the parties and to take further recourse to the remedy available under law.

Permitted to do so.
