The petitioner seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.190, dated 9.12.2018, registered under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act 1985 registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has been in custody since 9.12.2018 approximately.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from HC Sukhmandar Singh has prayed that instead of releasing the petitioner on bail, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial. She has stated that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 31.10.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

I find this to be a fair submission. Consequently, even while

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dismissing this petition, the Trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude its entire evidence on or before 31.10.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed.
