The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 171 dated 01.11.2018 registered under Sections 306, 349 IPC at Police Station Chhajli District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over four months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as examination of Pws has not yet started. There is no other case pending/decided against the petitioner and, thus, she may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 20.03.2019 prepared by Sh. Harpreet Singh, PPS Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur, has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual sentence of four months and sixteen days and there is no criminal case pending against her.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be

released on regular bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
