FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 19.12.2018 of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur has been received whereby after recording statements of respondent/complainant Reenu and accused/petitioner Rohit Kumar, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Vashnno Dass submits that the victim Reenu has not received any injuries in this incident and only an attempt to throw acid was made and, thus, there is no injury upon the person of the victim. Thus applicability of offence u/s 326-B IPC is a debatable issue.

Accused/petitioner Rohit as well as complainant Reenu, who have appeared before the Court have vouched for their settlement

that has been arrived at between the parties and have stated that they have no objection if the FIR in question is quashed.

Heard.

In the light of statements made by the parties and together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 72 dated 17.06.2016 registered at Police Station Dhariwal District Gurdaspur under Section 326-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
