This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of previous service rendered by the petitioner in Government aided schools.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), to decide the legal notice dated 12.01.2019 (Annexure P-7), served by the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in *Sunil Kumar Sharma and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*, CWP-4629-2012, decided on 19.02.2018.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), to consider legal notice dated 12.01.2019 (Annexure P-7), served by the petitioners in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in ***Sunil Kumar's case*** (supra) and decide the same within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
