AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 12.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.17323 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to pay the amount on account of interest of delayed payment at the rate of 9% per annum from the due date till the date of payment within a period of three months.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed reply by way of affidavit of Gurlovleen Singh Sidhu, Managing Director, PRTC, Patiala mentioning the calculation of Gratuity, Leave

Encashment and GPF, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives. However, he seeks liberty to revive the petition or to avail remedies in accordance with law, if any discrepancy is found in the reply filed.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous, with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
