Petitioner was granted 6 weeks parole by Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Rupnagar. Petitioner claims that he has medical problem in perennial area of body. In the jail, he was also rushed to Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh, where treatment was given to him. Major surgery was performed on 27.2.2019. He is bed ridden and is unable to walk. His treatment is still going on. He is to visit GMSH, Sector-16, Chandigarh.

The State was directed to submit report as to whether such treatment is available in jail or not. The Medical Officer, District Jail, Rupnagar, submitted report that patient is K/C/O Psoriasis + Perineal Cellulitis + Septicemia + Fourniers Gangrene. He is getting treatment from Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh. It is stated that District Jail, Rupnagar, does not have nursing staff for such patients and is not possible to manage patient Rajinder Kapur at Dispensary, District Jail, Rupnagar. In OPD slip of PGI, treatment is advised for 4 months.

In these circumstances, parole of petitioner is extended by 2 months initially. Further extension can be considered depending upon medical condition of patient. Petition is allowed.
