KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

This intra Court appeal under Clause X of the Letters Patent is directed against the order dated 15.02.2019 dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellant-petitioner seeking a mandamus to command the respondents to carry out the measurement of his height afresh for the purpose of determining the merit. The grievance of the appellant-petitioner was that the measurement of his height during the selection process was not correctly recorded. Learned Single Judge finding that there is no material available with the appellant-petitioner to contradict the measurement recorded during the selection process, dismissed the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the appellant-petitioner states that the petitioner has a medical certificate which certifies his height to be 6 feet 3 c.m. whereas during the selection process it has wrongly and illegally been recorded as 5'11.3". Now that since the appellant-petitioner alleges that he

has a medical certificate certifying his height to be different from what was recorded during the selection process, though he has not placed any such certificate on record of this appeal, we deem it appropriate if the appellant-petitioner approach the learned Single Judge by making an appropriate application in this regard along with the requisite material to substantiate his claim.

The appeal accordingly stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
