B.S.WALIA, J. (Oral)

1. After arguing for sometime learned counsel for the petitioner state that he does not press the revision petition qua the claim for further cross-examination of PW-1, Amarjit Kaur and that the revision petition qua the same may be dismissed as not pressed. He further states that one opportunity be granted to the petitioner-defendant to lead evidence on such terms as to costs as deemed appropriate failing which irreparable loss would be occasioned to the petitioner-defendant.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, revision petition qua the claim for further cross-examination of PW-1, Amarjit Kaur, is dismissed as not pressed. As regards challenge to order dated 08.03.2019, liberty is granted to the petitioner-defendant to move an appropriate application before the learned trial Court to seek recall of order dated 08.03.2019 closing evidence of the

petitioner-defendant by order and for grant of opportunity to lead evidence on such terms as to costs as deemed appropriate by the learned trial Court in accordance with law.

4. Application, if any be moved within one week from today. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to make a prayer before the learned trial Court to defer the proceedings listed before it for today to enable the petitioner to move application as referred to above and to await the decision on said application. Needless to mention in case any such prayer is made, the learned trial Court would defer the proceedings listed before it today for appropriate period of time to enable the petitioner to move the application as above and till such time that order is not passed on said application.

5. Revision petition disposed of in aforementioned terms.
