The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Govind Ram in case FIR No.333 dated 25.08.2017, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 186, 188, 307, 332, 353, 452, 506, 511, 121, 121-A, 122, 141, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code; Sections 3, 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 and Sections 3 & 4 of the Explosive Substances Act, at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

Heard.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner are that he is the devotee and spokesperson of the Dera. He has played active role in the riots at Panchkula on 25.08.2017.

Challan has been filed on 24.10.2017. Charges have been framed on 22.02.2018. Petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2017. Trial has not been concluded and now the case is fixed for 09.05.2019.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the court.
