Petitioners (two in number) had filed the present petition claiming to be a run away couple having married against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 7. In order to protect the interest of petitioner No.1, petitioner No.2 was directed to make necessary arrangement for depositing Rs.1.00 lakh in the name of petitioner No.1. The main petition was disposed of vide order dated 14.03.2019. Since the fixed deposit receipt was not produced, therefore, office has listed this matter before the Court.

On 22.05.2019, Station House Officer, Police Station Ratia, Fatehabad was directed to convey the order to petitioner No.2 and get the same implemented. On 03.09.2019, HC Amarjit Singh, Investigating Officer was directed to ensure the presence of petitioner No.2 on the next date of hearing.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Amarjit Singh- Investigating Officer has submitted that both the petitioners are not found residing at the given address.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court is left with no choice but to direct the office to close this file.
