GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.72 dated 27.6.2015 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.3.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioner/accused Som Raj and also of complainant Surinder Singh have

been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.72 dated 27.6.2015 registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
