Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 for submitting final report after conducting fair investigation in case FIR No.231 dated 26.07.2018, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala. Further prayer has been made for adding the name of Bhagwant Singh Head Cashier PNB as an accused in the above FIR. Lastly, it has been prayed that the direction be issued to the official respondents to arrest the accused.

On 15.03.2019, notice of motion was issued by this Court and pursuant to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Manpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Rajpura, District Patiala dated 10.05.2019 was filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4.

As per this reply, the challan against 7 accused persons was filed by the police on 20.10.2018 and 05.02.2019.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned

counsel for the petitioner that the charges were framed and the prosecution evidence is being recorded. It is also not disputed by the learned counsel that neither Bhagwant Singh was summoned as an accused nor the order framing charges was challenged by the petitioner to press his prayer for cognizance against said Bhagwant Singh.

Considering the above stage of the trial, this Court is not inclined to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

This petition is dismissed.
