The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.015, dated 17.2.2017, registered under Section 302 of the IPC, at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for more than two years and no other case is pending against him.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per the same the petitioner has been in custody for two years one month and one day and no other case is pending against him.

On the last date, the following order was passed :-

“ Learned State counsel submits that the complainant has been examined in this case but her cross-examination is due on 10.04.2019, thus, the hearing

may be deferred to any date beyond the said date.
Adjourned to 03.05.2019.”

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, states that full cross-examination of the complainant has not been conducted and the case is now fixed for 23.5.2019 and the prayer for grant of bail may be considered after that date.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail by the trial Court to its satisfaction after 23.5.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the cross-examination of the complainant.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
