On 14.03.2019, following order was passed:-

“The petitioner has approached this Court seeking writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus so as to seek release of his minor daughter namely Jaspreet Kaur, stated to be illegally confined by respondent No.5 Parminder Singh @ Nihang.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, I find that in fact FIR No. 292, dated 18.10.2018, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC (Annexure P-1) has already been lodged against respondent No.5.

Notice of motion for 26.3.2019.

SHO, Police Station, Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana (respondent No.3) is directed to make efforts to trace the alleged detenue and also to search the premises of

respondent No.5 and to submit his report on or before next date of hearing.”

Three separate replies have been filed by the State. It is the stand of the State that sincere efforts are being made to trace the minor daughter of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that non-bailable warrants have been got issued against respondent No.5 who is accused in FIR No.292 dated 18.11.2018, for 02.11.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondent-State to make sincere efforts to trace the alleged detainee.

With these directions, the present petition is disposed of.
