The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29303 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“At this stage, the present petition is being disposed of by giving direction to respondent No. 3 to give a personal hearing to the petitioner with respect to the letter dated 26.8.2018, as reflected in the impugned order dated 31.8.2018 (Annexure P-4) and pass appropriate order in accordance with law. In case, the work and conduct of the petitioners is not found to be satisfactory, they have no right to continue the work.”

Reply dated 19.8.2019 by way of an affidavit of Dilbag Singh Khatkar, Principal, Government Industrial Training Institute (Women),

Dumerkha Khurd, Jind filed today in Court is taken on record. Along with

the reply, order dated 20.2.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, liberty is sought to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
