Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for directing the respondents to conduct the post mortem examination
of brother of the petitioner, namely, Baljeet Singh (deceased), who
died on 11.03.2019 in the Army Quarter at Bareilly (Uttar Pradesh)
and whose dead body has been brought to District Jhajjar (Haryana)
on 13.03.2019.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court,
learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Ranbir
Singh, H.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, District Jhajjar
on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 3-State in the Court today. The
same is taken on record.

Perusal of the paragraph No.2 of preliminary submissions
made in the affidavit reveal that present petition has been rendered
infructuous as on the date of filing of the petition i.e. 13.03.2019, dead
body of the deceased was cremated at about 01:30. p.m as per Hindu

rites and customs.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
