Petitioner seeks a mandamus to direct the respondent/ authorities to release an amount of subsidy and to adjust such amount in the loan account of the petitioner taken under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme for the purpose of setting up of a Oil and General Mill.

The instant writ petition is completely bereft of any pleadings/ averments as regards the subsidy amount having been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner. No document in support thereof has been placed on record.

Under such circumstances, the prayer in the instant petition cannot be examined and dealt with.

Writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to agitate the matter afresh but after placing on record concrete evidence with regard to sanction of the subsidy amount.
