Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harinder Singh Police Station Airport District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar submits that in consequence of interim order dated 29.05.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail together with the fact as has been brought to the notice of the Court that the parties have already effected a settlement/agreement before the mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, copy of which has been placed on record as Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has business interest abroad, he be granted liberty to go abroad, if so necessitated.

Heard.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to go abroad if so necessitated upon necessary intimation to the trial Court by giving his

particulars of the visit and place.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.05.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
