Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is quashing of complaint no.COMA/95256/2016 dated 13.09.2016 pending before learned JMIC, Ludhiana and notice dated 14.09.2016, wherein the petitioners have been summoned to face trial for offence under Sections 12(1), 18, 19, 28 and 22 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are mother-in-law, father-in-law, sister-in-law and brother-in-law (husband of the sister-in-law) of the complainant.

On 19.01.2016, the respondent-complainant and her husband Harnish Sharma had made a statement that some minor dispute had arisen between them and therefore, the in-laws of the respondent-complainant

were annoyed with them, but now, the complainant and her husband have decided that they will live in a rented accommodation at Mohali or at any other place and they do not want any police action against any one. However, thereafter, the respondent-complainant filed an application under Section 12(1) of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, in which, the petitioners have been summoned.

Since the impugned order was passed on 20.10.2016 and the case is stated to be fixed for arguments, on discharge application, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of this petition, at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
