ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0113 dated 21.05.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 34, 506 IPC and offence under Section 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are alleged to have caused simple injuries to the complainant and the injury which attracts Section 326 IPC is attributed to co-accused Gurmail Singh, who has been released on regular bail.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 18.03.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurmeet Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 18.03.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
