AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 29.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.5220 of 2012.

The grievance of the petitioner in the writ petition was against the rejection of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police. The writ petition was allowed in terms of decision dated 15.01.2004 of this Court in CWP No.3258 of 2003 titled as ***Parsa Singh Vs. State of Punjab.***

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Jagdeep Kapil, Senior Assistant, Home Branch states that entire procedural process has been undertaken and the matter is pending only for

approval of the Chief Minister being competent authority. He states that needful will be done as soon as possible.

In view of statement made, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the petition, if need so arises.
