**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioners-Surjit Singh and Jasveer Kaur have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02 dated 08.02.2019, registered at Police Station NRI Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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As per the prosecution version, the present petitioners are the parents of Mrs. Parbhajyot Kaur Bhadala, who got married with the son of complainant. There is allegation that Mrs. Parbhajyot Kaur went to Canada and landed at International Airport, Toronto, secretly and did not contact the son of complainant etc.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 18.03.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 18.03.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
