The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0065 dated 24.02.2018, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has stated that the petitioner did not join the investigation.
