The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 17.10.2018, vide which, direction was issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representations of the petitioner.

Short reply by way of affidavit of the respondent filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the matter was considered, vide speaking order dated 05.11.2018 and necessary instructions have been given to the SHO concerned to maintain peace and tranquility. Further, a joint statement of the parties was recorded wherein they have undertaken not to give any threat, which is also placed on record as Annexure R-2-T.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that there was a specific direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Mansa to do the demarcation. However, the Deputy Commissioner, Mansa is not a party before this Court. In any case, as per the reply, the matter of demarcation

relates to the Roadways and Forest Department of the Government of Punjab, therefore, the petitioner is required to approach the concerned authority for doing the needful and in case an appropriate application seeking demarcation is filed by the petitioner to the appropriate authority, this Court has no doubt that the said authority shall consider and do the demarcation in terms of the order dated 17.10.2018 within four weeks of the receipt of the said application or to avail the remedy as available to the petitioner, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the contempt petition is dismissed with aforesaid liberty.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
