The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11, dated 27.1.2019, registered under Sections 306, 511, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, in the matter of suicide of her son-in-law.

Allegations are that the daughter of the petitioner had developed illicit relations with some one and, after having fought with the deceased, she moved in with her mother (the petitioner). On one day the deceased phoned the petitioner and asked her to send his wife back whereupon the petitioner had uttered some wrong words to him and being fed up with the behaviour of his wife, her paramour and his mother-in-law he committed suicide.

These essential facts are not disputed by learned DAG Punjab. In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
