Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.24 dated 17.02.2018 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kurali, Mohali.

On the joint request made by learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre vide order dated 21.01.2019 and the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation Centre, on 29.01.2019.

Accordingly, parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and a report has been received from the Mediator to the effect that the parties have settled their disputes by way of settlement/agreement and the compromise dated 19.03.2019 has been

reduced into writing.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 30.05.2018 is made absolute.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/compromise dated 19.03.2019 as entered between them before the Mediation Centre in letter and spirit.

In case, the parties violate the terms & conditions of the settlement/compromise, the parties shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition.
