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Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.50 dated 25.06.2018, registered at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 352, 426, 427, 448, 451 and 452 of the IPC and Sections 3 (1), (f), 3 (1) (r), 3 (1) (s) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015) (for brevity, 'SC & ST Act, 1989').

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Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

All the offences except Section 452 of the IPC and Sections 3 (1), (f), 3 (1) (r), 3 (1) (s) of the SC & ST Act, 1989, are bailable. The petitioner has been in custody since 01.03.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
