Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.741 dated 20.11.2018, registered at Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad, under Sections 420, 406, 465, 468, 506 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested this petition.

However today, none has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

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On the last date of hearing i.e. 23.05.2019, learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner is not cooperating during investigation and original documents of the complainant are with him. However, learned counsel for the petitioner admitted that documents are lying with the petitioner. He also stated that the petitioner has already supplied certified copies of those documents. In view of the above, the petitioner was directed to bring the original documents of the complainant.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not ready to hand over the original documents to the complainant.

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
