The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.130 dated 12.09.2017, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 Women, Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 state that now compromise has been effected between the parties and in pursuance thereof petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, is pending between the parties. At the first motion, Rs.5,00,000/- has been paid by the petitioner to respondent No.2-wife.

Keeping in view the circumstances, this court is of the view that the petitioner is entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 29.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
