The petitioner seeks parole for 4 weeks for admission of his children in the school. He has also impugned the order dated 25.2.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the respondent No.4, vide which parole has been declined.

In the reply filed, State has opposed the prayer of parole. It is stated that the petitioner is a hardcore prisoner. He was convicted under Section 302 IPC and sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life. Narcotic substance was recovered from him and further mobile phone was also recovered from him, for which he was convicted. He also remained absconded from prison for 5 years, 2 months and 19 days and was re-arrested on 14.3.2015, for which he was convicted in a separate trial.

I am of the view that according to the petitioner his son is studying in 3rd Class for which admission is automatic. It is the 3rd week of May and admission in the primary classes are already over. This petition is merely an excuse to get parole by the petitioner.
