Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.03.2018 (P-1) expeditiously.

In response to the notice of motion, issued by this Court, Status Report by way of affidavit dated 01.11.2018 of Sh. Davinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Nabha, District Patiala on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has already been filed and perusal of paragraphs 5 and 6 of the same reveal that complaint of the petitioner was duly examined, but no substance was found therein. Affidavit also reveals that enquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2, Patiala has already been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala as well. Photocopy of the enquiry order dated 11.08.2018, conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police has been placed on record and the same is

marked as 'X'.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter. Consequently, the present petition is disposed off. However, petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available against the report dated 11.08.2018, submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
