Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the re-fixation of his pay in view of the orders of this Court passed in CWP No.16084 of 1997 which was upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) being Civil Appeal No.8661 of 2009.

Petitioner claim that he is similarly situated with those who have been granted the relief by this Court but the same has not been granted to him only on the ground that he has not approached this Court and was not the petitioner in above mentioned writ petitions.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 09.12.2017 (Annexure P-8).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Charanjit Singh Bakhshi, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the Department has no objection in deciding the claim of the petitioner as being made by him in a representation in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the request made by counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation filed by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.
