GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioner-Ravinder Singh, seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered vide FIR No.9, dated 28.1.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC.
2. Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has informed that the parties have reached at an amicable settlement

pursuant to which a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed.

3. The aforestated position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.
4. Since, it is a case apparently having arisen out of matrimonial discord which has now been resolved, custodial interrogation is not warranted. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 18.3.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
