Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No. 5.

As per the case set up by the petitioner, the petitioner has entered into two years of contract with respondent No. 5 for transportation of wheat stock and loading and unloading from the godowns at Centre Warehouse C.W.C., B. D. Nabha.

As per the averments made in the petition, respondent No. 5 is also in the same business and is creating problems for the petitioner in performing his contract.

A perusal of the representation filed by the petitioner before S.S.P., Patiala shows that the petitioner is only asking for police help so as to enable him to perform his contract properly and to deter respondent No. 5 from interfering in his business.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

From the various complaints filed by the petitioner, no

cognizable offence is made out. The petitioner, if so required, can appoint his own security personnel for the purpose of his contractual liability.

Needless to say, the petitioner has filed a similar petition bearing No. CRM-M-6781-2019 and the same was dismissed as withdrawn on 13.02.2019, however, without disclosing the said fact, the petitioner has filed the instant petition.

In view of the above, finding no merit, this petition is dismissed.
