[1]. Vide order dated 01.11.2017 passed by the Division Bench, CWP No.24662 of 2017 was disposed of by directing the District Development and Panchayat Officer (DDPO), Patiala and Block Development and Panchayat Officer (BDPO), Ghanaur to hold a fact-finding enquiry and in case, the allegations of the writ petitioner were found to be substantiated, then appropriate action in terms of Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961 for removal of encroachments from the Panchayat land was to be initiated.

[2]. Admittedly, the Gram Panchayat filed a petition under

Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961 for eviction of unauthorized occupant of the Panchayat Land. Number of petitions were filed and the same have been allowed vide order dated 11.06.2018 passed by the Collector (Panchayat Land)/DDPO, Patiala.

[3]. If the petitioner has any grievance against the order of ejectment dated 11.06.2018, he can avail his remedy in accordance with law, but the proceedings under Contempt of Courts Act cannot be initiated as there is no violation of order dated 01.11.2017 passed by the Division Bench.
