Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 04.01.2019, submitted by the petitioner.

As per the case of the petitioner, he has married with one Balwinder Kaur and is having two minor children, however, the wife of the petitioner expired in the month of May, 2016 and the petitioner performed second marriage with Amandeep Kaur-respondent No. 4 in the month of July, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that thereafter, the marriage between the petitioner and respondent No. 4 witnessed a rough weather and respondent No. 4 filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. seeking maintenance in which she has stated that petitioner performed marriage with her on 10.03.2014 whereas, as per petitioner, the marriage was performed in July, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that respondent No. 4 has played a fraud with the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the petition as well as representation, I do not find that any cognizable offence is made out.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a complaint for redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
