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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)**

Petitioner has approached this Court, seeking issuance of directions pertaining to a fraudulent practice being carried out as regards incorrect declarations and installing uncertified and unsafe CNG Kits in old diesel vehicles and thereby causing hazard to the safety and security of the end users as well as loss to the state exchequer.

Placed on record and appended alongwith the petition at Annexure P-3 is a representation dated 05.01.2019 in which specific instances of the vehicles as also their registration numbers have been furnished.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the considered view that a writ Court ought not to embark upon a roving enquiry into the matter.

Be that as it may, it is an issue which requires examination and enquiry at the hands of the Transport Commissioner, State of Haryana/respondent No.2.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue the matter further with respondent No.2.
