Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the respondent authority to renew his arms licence bearing No. 129/DM/Jind/Feb.2013 and which otherwise stands expired on 19.2.2019.

It is the case of the petitioner that he had submitted an application for renewal on 6.2.2019 and had also deposited the requisite fee.

Statement of Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana is recorded to the effect that in case any application for renewal of the arms licence has been submitted by the petitioner and the same is pending, it would be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 and the rules framed thereunder and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from today.
