After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he has received a letter from the Haryana State Federation of Cooperative Sugar Mills Limited in response to his legal notice whereby he has been informed that as per the information received from the office of the Provident Fund Commissioner, the petitioners are not entitled for the grant of pension on the higher wages on the basis of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on the ground that the employer's share was not deposited on the actual salary though, the same was deducted from employees on their actual salary.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the said order.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
