The present petition was filed challenging for quashing of the FIR No.66 dated 27.02.2014 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City as well as the Order dated 23.01.2015 framing charges against the petitioner. It is not disputed by the parties that later on the charges were amended vide order dated 28.08.2015 and thereafter on 25.01.2018. By the last alternation, the offence punishable under Section 67-A of I.T Act, 2000 was added. This Court vide order dated 24.05.2018 had allowed the petitioner to amend the petition. The needful has not been done.

At this Stage, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the trial has commenced and out of 09 witnesses 03 have been examined.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner as well as the advancement of the trial, no case is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
