As per pleadings on record the petitioners herein are the registered owners of Tata Ace vehicles and are validly registered for carrying out commercial activity in the nature of carrying goods as also for passengers.

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that the respondent authorities are turning a blind eye to the activity of plying of unclassified vehicles and which do not carry any registration number and thereby causing a huge loss to the petitioners and who purchased their vehicles after obtaining loan facilities.

In the considered view of this Court, while exercising the extraordinary writ jurisdiction under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India a rowing inquiry into the matter may not be feasible.

Be that as it may, the instant petition raises an issue which should be looked into and addressed by the State Transport Commissioner, Haryana.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to pursue their grievance before respondent no.2.
