FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 01.10.2018 of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Sukhbeer Kaur and the accused petitioner No.2, namely Haravtar Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as per compromise/affidavit (Annexure P2) dated 28.03.2018 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.254 dated 22.08.2017 under Sections 406/498-A/354 IPC pertaining to Police Station Sidhwan Bet, Ludhiana and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
